

What is a Forest School Holiday Club?

Forest School sessions offer children and young people opportunities to achieve, and to develop confidence and self-esteem through hands-on, multi-sensory learning experiences in a local woodland environment. It is a process not a product-led initiative which enables each participant to take the learning their way, following their interests. During the holiday club, children will have the chance to learn new skills such as cooking food on open fire, using a range of tools to work with wood, building shelters or identifying plants and animals. Of course Forest School would not be complete without games, playing with mud and sticks, nature art or storytelling around the fire. Our site has a digging area, rope swings, hammocks and a mud kitchen for all to enjoy.

How should I dress my child?

We will be outside come rain or shine, doing active things therefore it is essential children have the right kind of outfit - layering is the key! The essential list includes:

- A sturdy pair of outdoor shoes walking boots are preferable to wellingtons as children have more grip and support
- Waterproof coat
- Warm jumper or fleece
- Waterproof, long trousers (or one you don't mind getting dirty or muddy)
- A set of clothes to change into (pants, socks, trousers)
- Sunscreen, hat

What about food?

We provide a morning and afternoon snack but children need to bring their own packed lunch and water bottles. Please let us know of any dietary needs in advance.
